Mrs. Look then shared Gabe and Tom both tested in the top 2.5% of junior students who took the PSAT/NMSQT last year in our region. Mrs. Look shared this was incredible accomplishment for these students. The Board of Education along with the Administration congratulated the students and wished them the very best in their promising future.

Dr. Gresham introduced Mr. Zimmerman; Assistant Principal at Limestone Community High School who attended tonight's meeting to provide an update to the Board of Education Members on the Advanced Placement Program. Mr. Zimmerman shared over the past few years LCHS has been working on aligning with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) by offering more Advanced Placement Courses. Mr. Zimmerman also shared that Limestone now offers eight Advanced Placement courses with one hundred twenty student participants compared to two courses previously offered with seventeen participants. The Board of Education Members along with the Administration discussed the benefits to offering Advanced Placement courses verses Early College courses and agreed the Advance Placement courses offer a wide variety of benefits to our college bound students.

Dr. Ryder presented and reviewed the FY '20 Audit Summary with the Board of Education Members. She shared the Audit took place in July of this year. Dr. Ryder informed the Board Members the findings from the FY '20 Audit are similar to the findings from the FY '19 Audit.
