As you are aware, it has been our administration's protocol to monitor the number of students and employees with positive cases of COVID-19 before we make decisions impacting attendance. After evaluating the most recent information, we have made the following changes to the end of the first semester and the beginning of second:

Monday and Tuesday, December 21-22

ALL Remote/Online Finals

All students will take their finals online.
Parents are to call students in absent for any class for which a student is not taking a final.
This call communicates that you are aware that a final is not being taken.

Teachers will email students and parents Google Classroom Codes during the day for all new classes that begin Second Semester on 1/6/2021

ROCKET DAY – All students receive remote instruction

All Instruction will be conducted remotely using the BLUE DAY bell schedule.

WHITE REMOTE DAY & Remote Supply Pick-up
All Instruction will be conducted remotely using the WHITE DAY bell schedule.
